ILLEGAL AND INCONSIDERATE PARKING ON GROVE ROAD



We were very saddened to hear how the coach carrying the Year 3 children back from their school trip was obstructed on Grove Road. It took the coach fifteen minutes to get through and drop the children and staff back safely. Some cars were parked illegally and the staff reported how one driver spoke in a rude manner to the coach driver. This is shocking and upsetting to hear and we hope this will not be repeated.

Please be considerate when parking and **do not** park over driveways, on the kerbs or on double yellow lines.

The zig zag School Keep Clear lines are marked with a sign to say no parking between 9am-5pm. We are working with the council to see if we can change the times to no parking between 9am-3pm and 3.30pm-5pm. We will notify you of the outcome in due course.

Please consider parking further away and walking to the school gate.

Parents have a responsibility to:

- be considerate of our children's safety at all times
- park safely and escort children to the classroom door
- allow plenty of time for your journeys so that you are able to park within the vicinity of the school
- not to park on pavements or obstruct driveways

ONLINE SAFETY - AGE RATINGS

Age ratings are useful to help you decide what is appropriate for your child. It is important to remember that apps and games are rated differently to films and there are lots more to consider.

App stores have classification systems but there are also developer's recommendations and PEGI ratings and often, not all of these match up. While they are a useful guide, not one of the rating systems takes full account of all risks that an app or game may present. For example, the PEGI rating considers the content of the game itself but doesn't take into account any risks associated with the communication features.

It is recommended therefore that you look further than just the age ratings when considering the suitability of the game for your child and also read reviews from other users, as well as downloading and trying the game yourself.
